Alcohol Concern is the national agency on alcohol misuse in the UK. We aim to reduce the impact of alcohol misuse on individuals, families and society and to increase the range and quality of services available to people with alcohol-related problems

Our work covers the wide range of public policy issues on which alcohol misuse impacts including public health, housing, crime and licensing. We also support the development of policy and practice in specialist areas such as primary care, mental health and the alcohol treatment sector.

Alcohol: the statistics

Alcohol costs the NHS up to £1.7 billion every year treating the chronic and acute effects of alcohol misuse

Up to 1.3 million children are affected by parental alcohol problems in the UK

Alcohol related crime and disorder costs up to £7.3 billion a year

One in four A&E attendances are due to alcohol

Of those people with an alcohol problem, 17 out of 18 cannot access the help they need



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
